

that the world-wide Church has either failed to perceive, ignored or shrunk from ministering - until now. We have, for the most part, been quite unaware that we have been keeping some of the children's Bread from them.

CONCLUSION

Every ministry has its rightful place in the sovereign plan and provision of God. They are all complementary to each other and may overlap considerably in the building of God's Kingdom. But never let us forget that if preaching, or praise, or sanctification, or healing, or medicine, or all of them put together could remove all the kingdoms of darkness from the human soul, then Jesus would never have needed to command, "Come out of him, and enter him no more!" All the cowardice and cleverness of men seeking an easier alternative solution will perish on the Rock of the Word of Jesus Christ.

Let us remember then, that the classical biblical solution to demonisation is the ministry of deliverance. Other ministries may substitute or suffice from time to time but that is more by the grace of Christ and the presence of Christ rather than the spiritual wisdom of the Church.

It is a ministry of LOVE, because it is the love of Christ for the sufferer - in you - that motivates the Christian leader to go into battle, when it would be so much easier to apply some or all of the other possible solutions - hoping for the best. But to get the best results, you have to apply the best provision or gift that God has given you for meeting the needs of His people.
